CHANGE TO THE NOTICE OF RACE

Addendum L does not apply to M72 and is replaced by this on the water umpiring system:

In order to minimise protests Jury members may follow the racing on the race course. If they observe a red flag they will use the following signals to help boats take appropriate action:

- (a) A green and white flag with one sound means 'The judges saw the incident and believe that no rule was broken.'
- (b) A red flag with one sound means 'The judges saw the incident and believe that one boat has or more boats have broken a rule.' The judges will hail or signal each boat identified.
- (c) A yellow flag with one sound means 'The judge(s) did not observe the incident or are unable to make a decision'.

The signals displayed by the Jury Boat are for information only. If a red flag is displayed, the identified boat is not obligated to take a penalty. This system does not limit the right to protest another boat, whatever flag is displayed or not by the umpires.

This changes 3.5 of the Notice of Race.

CHANGE TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

11.1 For the M72 Class RRS44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
